I. Study Expense at CCU

II. Scholarship

There are two types of scholarship available for international students to study at CCU: (1) **Taiwan Scholarship** (Sponsored by Taiwan Government); and (2) **CCU International Student Scholarship** (Sponsored by CCU). We recommend international students apply for both, despite that each student can only receive one award. Below is summary of these two types of scholarship.

Taiwan Scholarship

There are mainly two types of Taiwan Scholarship: (1) MOE Scholarship sponsored by Ministry of Education (MOE) and MOFA Scholarship sponsored by Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA). All applications will be processed by the nearest Taiwan Consulate Office or TECO office near your residence ([List of Consulate or TECO office](#)). Please contact these offices for application details. These offices will begin processing your application **from Feb. 1 each year with application deadline on March 31. All Taiwan Scholarship applications should be mailed to the nearest Taiwan Consulate Office or TECO office near your residence, postmarked by March 31.**
